

Nuremberg = everything on .opensuse.org not in Provo


- 25 real machines

- 1 serial console server; 1 KVM server
- Different FC-Storages from SUSE SAN (~28TB)

- Cluster of 3 machines for forums, wikis and wordpress instances
- Database cluster incl. storage








Infrastructure highlights



5) Refresh our hardware base


But HOW?





Goal 1: Better promotion

- Work closer together with the marketing guys
 - get 1:1 relationships between developers and marketing
- Start writing blog entries about our stuff
 - give marketing something to work with
- Give talks
 - As this is nothing for everybody: choose a "talk master"
 - Tell people what we have be open for suggestions







Goal 2: Increase communication

- Implement public Ticket system for admin@opensuse.org
- Check if we need more public monitoring
- Promote admin@o.o; ftpadmin@o.o; mirrors@o.o; IRC
- Think about "infrastructure consultation days/hours"
 (like others have their bugsquashing days/hours) and/or an own IRC channel

Goal 4: Rules and guidelines

- Implement "infrastructure mentors" acting as teacher and mentor for new admins
- Stay open and flexible but also conservative in terms of security and maintenance
- Check the "openSUSE Infrastructure Policy" together with the board and announce it ...

Users expect services to be:

- reachable 24/7
- always up-to date
- Secure



Can you give me your number, please?

- Make sure that at least someone is reachable:
 - Get Email, Telephone and/or IRC name
 - Get root access for some people getting paid for service
 - Have all available updates installed at any time
 - Secure the machines and services • Use monitoring and react before anyone noticed a problem
- Have backups at hand
 - Shutdown unneeded services


