

**NAME**

**sto** – A file archiver like **tar**.

**SYNOPSIS**

**sto** [**c|x**] <archive>[- file1, ...

**DESCRIPTION**

**sto** is a file archiver that creates uncompress file archives that are similar in design to those produced by **tar**(1), except that **sto** is incompatible with **tar**(1).

The **sto** archiver takes at least 2 arguments to work. The first argument must be either **c** or **x**, which start up **sto** in either creation or extraction mode, respectively. The second argument is a file to create or extract, or if **-**, use *stdin* or *stdout*. At this time, writing to *stdout* is unimplemented, and trying to do so will create a file – with the archive contents. **sto**, if invoked in creation mode, will add all files listed on the remainder of the command line to the archive. If **sto** was invoked in extraction mode, all extra arguments after the archive name are ignored.

**BUGS**

Directory support has not been added. Also, there is no way to make sure that the file headers are actually **\*valid\*** file headers. Only a archive header check is preformed, and invalid file headers aren't checked for.
